

## **ADMISSION TO THE NCCDP**

The Executive Director/Associate Director may accept a Dental Professional into the North Carolina Caring Dental Professionals if:

- (a) The Dental Professional has voluntarily agreed to obtain an assessment from an appropriate approved Treatment Program and has voluntarily withdrawn from his/her practice or limited the scope of his/her practice as determined by the Executive Director/Associate Director and Treatment Provider.
- (b) The Dental Professional has acknowledged his/her impairment and has voluntarily enrolled in an appropriate approved Treatment Program and has voluntarily withdrawn from his/her practice or limited the scope of his/her practice, as determined by the Executive Director/Associate Director and Treatment Provider.
- (c) The Dental Professional agrees to enter into a Participation Agreement with the NCCDP.
- (d) If a Dental Professional previously has been a participant and seeks to re-enter the NCCDP, the Compliance Committee will review the case to determine whether the Dental Professional will be accepted back into the NCCDP. The Professional must establish, to the review Committee's satisfaction and in its discretion, that he or she should be allowed to re-enter the Program.
