

Service Agreement

A Service Agreement specifies the terms under which the North Carolina Caring Dental Professionals Program (CDP) will serve as a monitor for the North Carolina Board of Dental Examiners (NCBDE) for a predetermined period of time

The Service Agreement participant agrees to certain terms and conditions of the Monitoring Agreement with CDP for the NCBDE:

Agrees to submit to random, observed urine and blood tests and, in some instances, hair analysis, at their own expense on a schedule determined by CDP.

Authorizes CDP to obtain tests results and other information from the testing agency and disclose all information it obtains about these results concerning the participant to the NCBDE, its members, employees, or agents for its use in the discharge of its duties.

Agrees to voluntarily cease practicing dentistry immediately upon receiving notification of any unexcused, missed, diluted or positive drug or alcohol screen results and shall not resume practice until permitted to do so by the NCBDE.

Understands that they are not a participant in CDP and that CDP will not act in an advocacy role for them before the NCBDE, other State Licensing Boards, Hospitals, Dental Societies, the Drug Enforcement Agency or others.
